WARNING: DO NOT LEAVE THE STARTPOINT UNTIL YOU HAVE VERIFIED THAT ALL PAPERWORK IS IN YOUR RALLY PACKAGE. THIS IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY!

PLEASE REMEMBER, bonuses are not in any particular order. You do NOT have to do bonuses at all (although most people would at least pick up the gas bonus). Once you pick your poison (while you may visit bonuses in any order you want, you may not mix bonuses from one set of bonus listings, in this case, you must choose to do no bonuses or the bonuses on Poison #1 or the bonuses on Poison #2 or the bonuses on Poison #3), you may pick zero, one or any combinations of bonuses that you want to do. For example, you may choose to only go to Sequoia National Park on Poison #3 and skip the ride over to Nevada or Utah... You may do bonuses in any order you want. If you think it is better to go to Beatty, Nevada first and then go back to Sequoia National Park, then feel free to do so! But you cannot then run over to Parkfield, California as it is on Poison #1...

IMPORTANT CAUTION: The following Potential Bonus locations are like a restaurant menu. If you order everything on the menu and eat it, you are going to get sick and perhaps die. Please pick and choose bonus destinations carefully!

NOTE: All times are local!

Checkpoint Information - Kennewick, Washington

The next checkpoint is Tuesday, August 31, 1999 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. in Kennewick, Washington 2,000 points

Rally staff will be available at 2 p.m. for early check-in.

Time penalty begins 6:00:01 p.m. After 6:00:00 p.m. there will be a 5 point per minute penalty for being late. "Minutes" will be rounded up at one second past the key time. For example, 6:00:01 (one second past 6:00 p.m.) will be counted as 1 minute late. Any rider who arrives after 8 p.m. (8:00:01 p.m.) will not receive credit for making this checkpoint, will not receive bonus points for this leg of the rally, and may not collect bonus points for the next leg of the rally.

Bonus listings will be handed out at 8:00 p.m. for the next leg of the rally. Riders may depart upon receipt of paperwork.

Directions from Interstate-82: Coming either from the north or the south, take the "Clearwater/Badger Road" exit (Exit 109). At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn RIGHT onto Clearwater Avenue (left takes you to Badger road, wrong way). Continue on Clearwater approximately 2-3 miles and you come to a stoplight at the intersection of Clearwater and Columbia Center Blvd. Continue on through this intersection, still on Clearwater Avenue. The dealership is just under a mile from this intersection, on the right-hand side, in a small strip mall about 100 yards off of Clearwater. There will be many large RED and WHITE balloons tied to the street sign "Quay Road," which is the actual side street you'll need to turn right onto, so be looking for these balloons.

Maricopa, California is located just north of the intersection of CA-166 and CA-33, approximately 67 miles north of Ojai and 25 miles west of I-5 in south-central California.

NOTE: CA-166 and CA-33 join for approximately 14 miles, Maricopa is just north of the western most intersection of the highways.

Parkfield, California 275 points Available 24 hours daily

Take a picture of any structure (building, water tower, etc) that mentions Parkfield to prove you were in Parkfield, California ID Flag must be in photo!

Parkfield is located in central California approximately ½ way between I-5 and US-101 in central California. It is directly northeast of Paso Robles, California.

San Simeon, California 250 points Available 24 hours Daily

Pick up a gas receipt from any gas station in San Simeon, California.

San Simeon, California is located on CA-1 on the Pacific Ocean approximately 1/2 way between Los Angeles and San Francisco and approximately 45 miles northwest of San Luis Obispo which is at the intersection of US-101 and CA-1 .

Monterey, California 190 points Available 24 hours daily

Pick up a gas receipt from any gas station in Monterey, California.

Monterey, California is located on CA-1 approximately 90 miles northwest of San Simeon, California near the intersection of CA-1 and CA-68 near the Pacific Ocean and to the southwest of Salinas, California.

San Francisco, California 55 points Available 24 hours daily

Pick up a toll receipt from the Golden Gate Bridge

NOTE: Like all bridges on the rally, should a toll not be collected in the direction you are traveling, you will need to backtrack to collect it. If any bridge does not collect tolls for motorcycles and you cannot pay the auto rate, you may take a picture of the bridge (with your rally id flag in it) to receive credit.

The Golden Gate Bridge is located on the northern tip of San Francisco on US-101.

Mt. Saint Helens National Volcanic Monument 400 points Available DAYLIGHT HOURS!

Windy Ridge

Washington

Ride to the end of Forest Service Road 99 located inside Mt. Saint Helens National Volcanic Monument on the EAST side of the park and take a picture of Spirit Lake OR the visitor amphitheater (this is a very small amphitheater with seating for just a few people) OR the "Windy Ridge View Point" sign OR the road closed sign at the end of the road in the park. Your id flag must be in the photo!

NOTE: While you maybe able to ride into the park at night, we will not accept your photo unless taken during daylight hours.

Mt. Saint Helens NVM is located in southwestern Washington state to the northeast of Portland, Oregon. The end of the road on the EAST side of Mt. Saint Helens is located approximately 20 miles west from the intersection of Forest Road 25 and Forest Road 99 on the east side of Mt. St. Helens. There are several routes possible to the EAST side of Mt. St. Helens (all roads are paved). Once in the immediate area, the state of Washington has done a good job marking different routes up to the mountain.

WARNING: If you do not understand where to go, please see the rallymaster!

Miles, Washington - 220 points – Available 24 hours per day.

Take a picture to show you were in Miles, Washington (see NOTE) OR pick up a receipt from the Fort Spokane Store and Restaurant (509-725-5783 near the intersection of WA-25 and the road heading southwest back toward US-2; the locals call this the "US-2 Cutoff") OR take a picture of the Fort Spokane Store and Restaurant. Your id flag must be in the photo!

NOTE: Part of Miles was flooded years ago to expand Coulee Dam Recreation Area. This is a really small town and there is not much left of it. If you cannot quickly find a Miles sign (any sign will do as the few remaining ones tend to be stolen by people wanting to say they've been to Miles) to show you were in Miles, then take a picture of the Fort Spokane Store or purchase something from the store and get a receipt (the store is open daily 8 a.m. to 9 p.m., but you can take a picture 24 hours a day).

Miles, Washington is located northwest of Spokane, Washington on WA-25 near the junction of the Franklin Roosevelt and Spokane rivers.

The Tar Pits are centrally located between I-405, I-10, and US-101 south of Hollywood and east of Beverly Hills. From I-405, exit on Santa Monica Boulevard. Follow Santa Monica east to Wilshire. Turn right on Wilshire to 5801. The Tar Pits are on the north side of the street. The best parking is on the back side of the park.

Ancient Bristlecone Pine Forest, California 480 points Available 24 hours daily

Take a picture of the plaque located near the Patriarch tree with the tree in the background. ID flag must be in the picture!

The Ancient Bristlecone Pine Forest is located northeast of Big Pine, California. From Big Pine, ride 13 miles east on CA-168, then north 10 miles on White Mtn Road to Visitor Center. Continue 12 miles further past the Visitors Center on the unpaved, but hard-packed road to "Patriarch Grove" which is well-marked. Follow the trail from that parking area approximately 1/4 mile to the Patriarch Tree and take a photo of the plaque (which is mounted on a rock) with the Patriarch tree in background (the Patriarch Tree is the largest known Bristlecone).

Kennecott Bingham Canyon Mine 570 points Available 8 am to 8 pm daily

Magna, Utah (approximately 15 miles directly west of Salt Lake City, Utah)

Take a picture of the open pit mine at the Visitors Center at Kennecott’s Bingham Canyon Mine. ID flag must be in the picture!

NOTE: If the visitors center is closed (i.e., you cannot get up to the mine AND you are there between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. local time, you may claim this bonus by taking a picture of the road and/or no visitors allowed sign)

From the Intersection of I-80 and I-15 in Salt Lake City, Utah, take I-80 west to UT-172. Ride south 3.3 miles to UT-201. Ride west on UT-201 3.4 miles to UT-111. Ride south on UT-111 to UT-48. Ride west on UT-48 to entrance gate and follow signs to Visitors Center.

several signs around the tree that are suitable for this photo to prove you were there. Your id flag must be in the photo!

Sequoia National Park, California is located in central California to the north of Bakersfield, California. The

Giant Forest is located on the main north/south road through the park near the center of the park approximately two miles north of Giant Forest Village. The area is well marked.

The General Sherman Tree is the worlds largest living organism and one of the fastest growing.

Pick up a gas receipt from Beatty, Nevada

Beatty, Nevada is located in western Nevada near the Nevada/California border on US-95 approximately 115 miles northwest of Las Vegas, Nevada.

Pick up a gas receipt from Cedar City, Utah

Cedar City is located in southwest Utah near the intersection of UT-56 and I-15.

Pick up a gas receipt from Salt Lake City, Utah.
